Very substantial:

The complete destruction or a fundamental change to the setting of a World Heritage Site, Scheduled Ancient Monument, grade I, II* and II Listed Building, grade I and II* historic parks and gardens and any other local, regional or nationally important sites that are considered under PPG16 criteria, so that the ability to understand and appreciate the site and resource is greatly altered.

Substantial:

The complete destruction or a fundamental change in the ability to understand and appreciate a site or feature which is a park or garden listed as grade II or shipwreck of special historic interest, conservation area, other sites of regional or county importance generally recognised in the development plan or a locally listed building or structure.

Moderate:

A minor change to a site or feature which is of international, national or regional importance or the complete destruction or a fundamental change to the site or feature that is considered to be of local interest or with local value for education or cultural appreciation.

Slight:

A minor change to the site or feature which is considered to be of local interest or a site with local value for education or cultural appreciation.

Not significant:

No material change to any of the sites or features of interest or a change to a site or feature with no significant value or interest.




Figure 5.11 Map showing the areas of archaeological interest across the site (after Wessex Archaeology 2006)




Figure 5.15 Detail of the 50m buffer zone imposed for development around each of the Bronze Age ring barrows
