



**THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BICESTER) (TRAFFIC REGULATION)
(AMENDMENT No.17*) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order is to introduce double yellow lines (prohibition of waiting at any time) in the following lengths of road:

- **Pioneer Way** - both sides for its entire length,
- **Hexham Road** - both side for its entire length, including the spur that leads in a south westerly direction to its southern junction with Whitelands Way,
- **Whitelands Way** - both sides, from its northern junction with Hexham Road north-east and north-westwards to a point 345 metres northwest of its junction with Pioneer Way.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Bicester) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1992 will be further amended accordingly.
