WELCOME TO KINGSMERE'S TRAVEL CHOICES

Real travel choices

Commuting could not be easier from Kingsmere, with two railway stations within walking distance and two bus services that run through the development, providing direct access to Bicester town centre, Bicester North railway station and Oxford city centre.

Additionally:

- There is quick access to London, Birmingham, Banbury, Leamington Spa, Oxford Parkway and Oxford by train.
- Bicester is a flat town, with all areas within a comfortable cycling distance.
- Kingsmere has on-site facilities within walking or cycling distance.
- You are only a short walk from the town centre, Bicester Business Park and Bicester Village.

 There are opportunities to share car journeys with other residents.

Oxfordshire County Council is further improving travel choices in Bicester (and information about them) as part of the Bicester Eco-town proposals.

Out and about

Explore the surrounding area and you will stumble across rambler footpaths and cycleways, country pubs and pretty villages, whilst being within easy reach of major businesses and shopping centres.

Travelling by foot is a quick and easy way of getting around Kingsmere. Due to Kingsmere's close proximity to central Bicester many local facilities can be reached via a short walk. Key destinations and approximate walking times are shown on the map below.

Key locations


Bicester town centre can be reached in a 15 minute walk, whilst Bicester Village railway station is around a 10 minute walk from the north east of Kingsmere. Bicester North railway station is situated 20-25 minutes walk away.

Additional local facilities can be accessed via a short walk, including supermarkets, local shops, leisure facilities, community hospital, primary and secondary schools. Good quality, direct and lit pedestrian routes are being installed through Kingsmere, connecting with routes to the town centre, Bicester Village and Bicester North railway stations and other destinations.

Kingsmere also provides many local opportunities for recreational walking trips.

Benefits

Whilst many health benefits are associated with walking, you can also help minimise environmental impacts caused by car travel by walking more often as part of your daily journeys.



DID YOU KNOW?

A brisk walk burns the same amount of calories as a run over the same distance!

It can:

- help beat stress: walking can make you feel good and more relaxed.
- cut your risk of heart disease by up to 50%, reduce the risk of type 2 diabetes and the risk of some cancers.
- boost your immune system for 24 hours.
- even lower your blood pressure.

Q walk

Kingsmere provides ample cycle opportunities with Bicester town centre located within a 5 minute ride, and 5-10 minutes to Bicester Village railway station and Bicester North railway station.

There is secure covered cycle parking at both railway stations, in the following locations:

- Bicester Village: By the station entrance;
- Bicester North: By the Bicester Village shuttle bus stop and also on the opposite side of station approach.

Q Bicester Village/Bicester North

Part of the National Cycle Network (Route 51) runs along the A41 past Kingsmere.

Whilst cycling can help to incorporate exercise into your daily routine it also acts as an efficient way of travelling in terms of both time and money.

Bicester Bike Loan

Bicester Green is host to a fleet of Cherwell District Council owned bikes that are fully maintained and offered out to hire from our workshop.

The scheme, aimed at getting people out of their cars and onto bicycles, allows you to take up the opportunity of a free cycle loan as part of the 'Cycle for Bicester' programme. 'Cycle for Bicester' encourages more people in Bicester to give cycling a try.

You can borrow either a traditional bicycle or could try a folding Brompton bike.

Accessories such as trailers, children's tail bikes and child seats are also available.

- New crossing points have been provided on Middleton Stoney Road, linking Kingsmere to the existing communities.
- Cycle parking is available to the rear
 of the southbound X5 bus stop on the
 A41, at the Kingsmere Park and Ride
 Site and at Bicester Village and Bicester
 North railway stations, to support
 connections to public transport.

O bicester

Kingsmere is served by two local bus services providing residents with direct access to Bicester and Oxford city centre.

The no.26 bus service runs directly through the development connecting you to Bicester town centre (and additionally to Bicester North railway station during peak hours). The S5 to Oxford also runs through the site at peak times. At other times it can be accessed from the Kingsmere Park and Ride site or stops on the A41 Oxford Road.

The X5 bus service (Cambridge, Bedford, Milton Keynes and Buckingham to Oxford, via Bicester) can also be accessed from stops on the A41 Oxford Road. It is possible to interchange to additional services in Bicester town centre or Oxford city centre.

Thames Travel additionally run the 25a Oxford to Bicester bus service (approximately hourly Monday to Saturday) via Middleton Stoney Road.



Contactless payment is now available on board the 26 and the S5 services. Use your contactless payment card or phone (i.e. ApplePay) to pay for your ticket when boarding.



The proximity of local railway stations operated by Chiltern Railways mean Kingsmere is highly accessible to destinations further afield.

Newly re-opened Bicester Village railway station has services to London Marylebone and Oxford Parkway. A direct line to Oxford also opened in December 2016.


Additionally there is Bicester North railway station with services to London Marylebone, Birmingham Moor Street, Birmingham Snow Hill, Leamington Spa and Banbury.

Car Sharing

You can cut the cost of your journey by registering as a member of a car share website. It works both ways meaning you are able to share your journey either as a driver or by joining someone else as their passenger, which is a great way of travelling to work or further afield.

Oxfordshire Car Share

Oxfordshire County Council and the UK's largest car-share network, Liftshare have created a partnership scheme.

They provide a matching service for all those who live or work in and around Oxfordshire as well as longer journeys to other locations outside the county. Once you have been matched, you can choose to journey share as little or as often as you like, with whomever you choose.

The service is available to anyone over 18. Joining the scheme is simple and completely free. All you have to do is register your details and then activate your account. Once you've registered your journey, the database searches for possible matches. When you have found a suitable match, you can then contact the member(s) using our internal messaging system.
