Comments	Further to the resubmission of more detailed plans I and my family would like to resubmit our total object to the project- For reasons previously stated- Damage and destruction to the environment/building on a greenfield site/destroying wildlife habitat/ increasing flooding and drainage issues Destruction of a historic village by swamping it with a significant population increase which in turn will create much more traffic , which is at school times often grid locked. Building outside the village boundary in contravention of its current classification .CDC has met its current targets for housing. The Developers application feels disingenuous- 60 houses are proposed BUT current estate architects build 30-40 houses /hectare on new sites. Hence should this be granted upto 200 new homes could emerge. This would overwhelm the current village and further magnify all the other objections(recent examples in nearby villages) It creates a precedent to extend up to the marina boundary and potentially to Appletree road and gives a green light to all speculative planning applications along this road. The village and neighbours will ultimately be subsumed into an urban sprawl. New Surgery proposals Carter Jonas /Obsidian are incorrect in their application. Cropredy surgery is a new bespoke building constructed this century on agricultural land specified for healthcare use only The partners have advised it is too small for their needs. This applies to the majority of GP practices in Banburyshire and beyond. Most of them have been on waiting lists for help much before Cropredy. The partners have advised they have no extra funding from BOB ICB /NHSE etc to secure the land and build what would be a multimillion pound project. The NEW plans look to cater for 10 to 12 thousand or more patients. Whilst an unfunded pipedream, were it ever to come to fruition again the village infrastructure would be overwhelmed . Should this expensive proposition (even if it could be funded and staffed) be allowed to destroy the area for ever? Aga
