Whilst there is support for the mast the proposed site is not appropriate , it is in a residential area and on the main thoroughfare through the estate. Having visited the one situated in Leach Road, Bicester, they look like a mini Post Office tower (London) we are amazed permission was granted there. There are many more suitable/ less intrusive locations on Langford Village , many have been mentioned in residents objections. We have conducted a Face Book poll and there are many complaints/ objections regarding the proposed location. We feel the company is proposing the cheapest most convenient for them rather than what is best for Langford Village. There has been no publicity or notification regarding this proposal, we as the Community Association are supposed to be listed as consultees for any applications relating to planning applications on the estate (none residential) and we have not received any notification. There is no consultation with the houses nearby, why? We hope the CDC Planning will turn down this proposal with the feedback to the applicant to go back to the drawing board regarding its location and look. places for consideration are; The roundabout near the current proposed location, with the pole disguised to fit in as much as possible to the surroundings, a discreet place on Langford Park, again made to fit in the surroundings., along Gavray Drive away from residential dwellings again disguised to fit in with the surroundings.
