Comments	<input type="text" value="Whilst Banbury town centre is characterised by failing retail and under-utilised and obsolete former industrial buildings, the expansion of the town's perimeter with more and more housing continues unabated. Given the lack of employment opportunities in Banbury town itself, inevitably the new housing causes yet more pressure on road infrastructure as residents drive further afield to place of work. The town has become a 'polo' - bulging around the outside but a sad hollow of limited activity in the centre. More should be done by the Council to encourage regeneration of the town centre to restore its lost vibrancy- the site north of Hanwell Fields risks further blurring of the town boundary with the outlying villages, which would damage the inherent and historic character of these areas for ever"/>
