T1 (Horse Chestnut) - crown lift specifically seeking to remove sub-lateral branches - Subject to TPO 01/2017

Amended 09/6/2022

T1 Horse Chestnut – Crown lift to provide a ground clearance of up to 5m by removing epicormic growth/small diameter branching from the main stem & primary union,

Remove/reduce smaller diameter undulating secondary branching of the crown periphery to provide a ground clearance of 5m.

Appraisal

The proposed works are considered minimal with little impact on the form or amenity the tree offers.

The proposal in itself is good management, not expected to be of detriment to the tree's longevity or form.
