We are aware that the proposers of this application are asking for an extension to prepare for the planning meeting, so that they can obtain further answers as to how they might fund a new doctor's surgery.

As a resident who would be directly affected by the proposed development, I am writing to strongly oppose any delay in the planning meeting. We know that Obsidian wish to get figures to show that a new surgery would be feasible and are using this new surgery to gain support from villagers for their planning application.

I feel it is very unfair that Obsidian would be offered an extension for their work, meanwhile Cropredy residents will be continuing to live with anxiety and frustration because of the planning application. It is particularly unfair since when the initial application was filed, we were given very little time to lodge objections. I believe we first had notice of the application on 24th April 2023 and the deadline for objections was 20th May. Given that Obsidian had at that time spent a lot of resources on this project, it placed them in a very strong position. I don't feel that any further benefits should be extended to Obsidian.

We also know that facilities which are offered as an inducement in a planning application do not necessarily get built.
