Please see my major concerns and objection to the proposed house build in North Crorpedy

- the marina and houses on Creampot Lane regularly flood which will only worsen with the build. It will also create more flooding to those that either experience floody already or back onto the site and will be impacted by this

- there is a significant lack of secondary schools in the area that would be unable to support families moving to the area
