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Dear Sir/Madam

I would like to add my objection to the application (23/000977/OUT) to build 60 new dwellings in Cropredy. I am a resident of Williamscot and this new development will add a huge amount of traffic to what is already a busy road. If each of these new houses were to average 2 cars per a household that is an extra 120 vehicles that could be going through Cropredy and Williamscot which is far more than the village infrastructures can accommodate. As most employment is out of Cropredy I do not believe that the traffic levels will be impacted as little as the application suggests.

The quickest way to the motorway and Banbury is through Williamscot and this road is already dangerous enough. We

have a 9 month old baby and walking to Cropredy to use the local amenities (cafe, park, Cropredy tots, doctors etc) is already less than ideal with the current levels of traffic and lack of pavement. Add in a big housing development and this will make it even more dangerous and will also result in those who would normally walk having to use their cars to do short journeys for their own safety - ultimately adding to the problem of emissions and congestion.
