Recommendation:

The submitted document is the Post-Excavation Assessment (PXA) for the archaeological Strip Map and Sample investigation at Compound 2A2 and Access at Land East of Station Road. Condition 9d can be partially discharged, however, the PXA for Compound 2A1, CFSA A1, Mill Meadow, Charbridge Allotments and Tythe Barn will also need to be submitted for the full discharge.

Detailed comments:

The applicant has submitted a Post-Excavation Assessment (PXA) from EWR Alliance for the archaeological investigation required by condition 9d.
