Thank you for re-consulting me on the above planning application. I have reviewed the submitted documentation and am disappointed to see that none of my concerns raised previously appear to have been addressed in the amended plans. For this reason, Thames Valley Police maintains a strong objection to this application, as we do not believe the application meets the requirements of;

- The National Planning Policy Framework 2021 paragraph 92(b); which states that Planning policies and decisions should aim to achieve healthy, inclusive and safe places which are safe and accessible, so that crime and disorder, and the fear of crime, do not undermine the quality of life or community cohesion...
- The National Planning Policy Framework 2021, paragraph 130(f) which states that "Planning policies and decisions should ensure that developments create places that are safe, inclusive and accessible... and where crime and disorder, and the fear of crime, do not undermine the quality of life or community cohesion and resilience".
- MHCLG's Planning Practice Guidance on 'Design', which states that; 'Although design is only part of the
  planning process it can affect a range of objectives... Planning policies and decisions should seek to ensure
  the physical environment supports these objectives. The following issues should be considered: safe,
  connected and efficient streets... crime prevention... security measures... cohesive & vibrant
  neighbourhoods.'

I ask that my comments previously provided are explicitly addressed by the applicant prior to permission being granted. I have copied in my previous response for ease of reference.
