<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="To echo the concerns of cropredy residents and beyond, the village infrastructure cannot cope with more housing - the school and surgery are already oversubscribed, this will only further strain the village services. The land provides beautiful serenity alongside the marina and this will soon be overcome by residential areas as this development will be a slippery slope into more of the village being turned into houses. In terms of public services, we do not have so much as a regular bus service and 60 or more houses will cause both traffic congestion and increase the pre-existing need for more services that are not met. It's not only the village of cropredy itself that needs to be taken into consideration, but surrounding villages such as Great Bourton which has recently had housing development and frustrated water pressure causing repetitive patch ups to fix this, when it should have been avoided to begin with by taking such frustrations into consideration. The plan is objectively ill-thought out highlighted by comments made by police and more, and so I object to the housing development."/>
