Comments	<input type="text" value="There is absolutely no need for fishing lakes or accommodation to be built here. Accommodation is already available around the area as well as a number of lakes/fishing facilities nearby. The plans are also quite misleading as on page 21 of the Site Access Appraisal, there's a pretty drawing of the site. Then suddenly all these details appear - representing 48 units, 23 huts, a 120 space car park and a big red building that looks like a house. Then they all disappear, to be replaced by the plan the applicants have applied for, with 15 units, eight pods and a 60-space car park. This is dishonest and misleading and considering who ATE Farms Ltd is managed by, this is a concern. The land is a haven for wildlife with protected species - it should be left alone and developers look if they truly wish to establish such a site. They are not doing this with any consideration of the views of the local people and seem only to want to make money."/>
