| <b>Comments</b>           | <p>This is an absurd application and totally out of step with the current needs of the local area. If allowed to go ahead this plan will cause immeasurable damage to local plant and wildlife, destroying habitat for wild deer and other indigenous species.</p> <p>The development would also cause huge issues with local transport infrastructure and roadways, many of which already suffer from huge traffic issues, crumbling roads, and contribute to loss of air quality.</p> <p>The local area is already struggling with limited health services, school places, and another development at this time (without funding from local authorities) will bring them to the brink of collapse.</p> <p>At a time when mortgage rates, rental rates, and cost of living is skyrocketing this development is totally unnecessary, most of the properties being too expensive for local residents to afford.</p> <p>There are far more appropriate spaces ready for development within the town limits, using existing industrial or abandoned land. To destroy perfectly good natural green land instead of concentrating on what is already available is farcical.</p> |
