Comments	<p>I support the idea of a community shop, but in this case the location for the proposal is impractical, and it's location needs to be revised.</p> <p>The extra traffic generated going to be a location by the South Green would be extremely damaging. There is already significant wear on the village hall carpark which would also be used by the proposed development site. As far as I am aware, neither the Parish or the Village Hall hall is responsible for resurfacing the car park. Extra traffic in terms of deliveries and customers to the shop would exacerbate the deterioration. In addition, the 'roads' across South Green are already badly worn and effectively 'single track'.</p>
