I am writing to express my grave concerns regarding the plans for the new Oxford United stadium proposed to be built near the Kidlington roundabout.

My daughter who lives in North Oxford has a number of medical conditions, one of which is life threatening. If she becomes unwell I need to be able to reach her to administer life saving emergency medical treatment and to call for paramedic help. There is only a short window in which this medication can be administered or she will go into a coma and not recover. On the last occasion this happened a few weeks ago I was called to stay she was becoming unwell and by the time I arrived less than 20 minutes later, she was unconscious.

The increase in traffic and the road closures proposed if the stadium were to be built would put her life at risk.

There is already a lot of cars parked in garden city when the small local Kidlington club are playing - many parked in such a way that getting out of garden city onto Yarnton Road can be very difficult. There are several alternative routes in this case but if the roads were closed and cars were parked near to the new stadium site (despite the club's assertions that everyone will use public transport that is either very naïve or misleading) the alternative routes for those of us who live in the village will be limited and long.

As Cherwell council I ask you to take into account the views of local residents over the wider community who won't have to live with this disruption.
