Objection to the building of a football stadium on the triangle at Stratfield Break

A totally inadequate number of parking spaces for both cars and away coaches has been put forward in this planning application.

Living in Garden City I already have issues getting in and out of my drive due to all-day parking by commuters to Oxford and London via Oxford Parkway This will exacerbated.

I know planning don't consider human rights on freedom of movement. However due to match day parking and the proposed road closures safety of movement is within the committee's remit to ensure Kidlington residents are not affected. Please don't build a stadium in this location that will violate residents' lives and safety.

Cycle network must not be compromised - two recent cyclist deaths on the boundary roads. A cycle network and pavement must be built to Peartree Park and Ride.

Removal of part of the bus lane into Oxford is unacceptable which will increase travel times for commuters to Oxford.

The triangle has only two accessible sides onto major roads so in a mass evacuation situation this is a serious safety issue - simply this land is the wrong shape and too small.

Building a commercial business where there is no special circumstance on our green belt between Oxford and Kidlington village. Leaving just a small piece of land by the roundabout is quite honestly inhumane to the wildlife currently living on and near to this biodiverse site.
