> I wish to object to the above planning application for the football stadium at Stratfield brake Kidlington.

> My concerns are

> 1. Match day road closure will bring traffic to a halt on roads that can easily become congested impacting on access to local shops and houses. Also pollution from stationary traffic is worrying.

> 2. Traffic in Kidlington is busy at all times of the day and is significantly worse when accidents on surrounding roads force cars to divert through Kidlington.
