I wish to reiterate my objections to the above planning application for a football stadium for Oxford United at Strawberry Brake, in the strongest possible terms.

It is a completely unsuitable application for the site.

It is currently a lovely area of Green Belt with an adjoining nature reserve and a cricket and rugby club. It is hugely enjoyed by many locals and is a vital and much-needed green space which should absolutely not be built over in any way.

The area is already extremely busy with traffic and a lot of housing, the latter sadly set to increase with the terrible plan to build housing on the beautiful North Oxford Golf Club. All the housing will only add to the tremendous overload on local roads.

This really is not a large enough site for the Oxford United Stadium. It needs to be in a much larger space which is not so close to residential areas and needs to have better more spacious road access.

Please turn this application down. It would be a real travesty to allow it and extremely sad for the area to be changed from its present much-loved sporting and leisure area in the Green Belt.
