Comments

- 1 The site for the proposed stadium has been chosen for its close proximity to the railway station. Therefore there would be no parking facilities provided. The railways are frequently on strike meaning away team supporters would drive here, and most would probably drive here anyway. Most people in favour of the proposal are not living locally.
- 2 The proposal is for residents to have parking permits but who will police this? Kidlington would be overcome with traffic looking for parking places which could lead to antisocial behaviour and problems of getting in and out of the village.
- 3 Supporters use of the park and ride car park would make it difficult, if not impossible, for residents to park there to go to Oxford or London.
- 4 Who would carry out crowd control? The police are already overstretched.
- 5 The proposal is to build on green belt land. What are the "exceptional circumstances" that make this possible?
- 6 If the main roads are to be closed for several hours before and after a match, how would local residents go about their lives?
