Introduction

This is a Reserved Matters application for Access only, dealing with the two bellmouth junctions providing routes into the site from Middleton Stoney Road.

It is identical to 23/00214/REM, for which a separate response will be sent.

Access arrangements

Spine Road junction

The red line area has been amended (on drg. 0001 Rev. P02) to incorporate a revised footway arrangement to the two bus stops. This tallies with the adjusted footway and cycle lane provision, as separately agreed, along the Spine Road, as shown on Rev. P03 of the Pedestrian & Cycle Link (Permanent) GA drg. no. 0006.

Details of the access will be finalised during the technical approval process of the Section 278 application.

Secondary Road junction

The red line area is similar to that shown on the previous revision. Pedestrian and cycle facilities, as agreed, outside of the area have been added for clarity.

The previous reason for objection, that the 5.5m width of the secondary road is too narrow for a bus service, has been addressed in separate correspondence. Adequate public transport provision will be achieved for an interim period from the service on Middleton Stoney Road prior to buses entering the site via the primary access road and the adjoining Axis J9 development. Therefore, buses will not route via the secondary road, and the 5.5m width is acceptable.

Details of the access will be finalised during the technical approval process of the Section 278 application.
