Comments

- 1 The developers' addition of a "surgery" adds nothing to the original application, which remains one for a housing estate in a small rural village. Indeed, one could question the motivation for publishing a design, especially such an obviously unsuitable one. Some might say that it is a ploy to deflect attention from the overall application. If anything, this makes the case against the application stronger, if indeed the building were to be built and the surgery did move into it.
- 2 There is no indication of provision of funding for commissioning the building either from the current practice partners or from the ICB.
- 3 One has to accept the partners' claim that they need more space, but the size of this building suggests an increase of thousands of patients (the car park alone can cater for 50 cars) or possibly provision of additional medical services for people outside the area who are not on their register, and would mean an even greater volume of traffic. No doubt the surgery would be pleased to increase their income with so many more patients on their list, but enabling them to do this should not be a matter suitable for inclusion in this planning application. There is an unsavoury feeling of being threatened with loss of our surgery if this is not approved.
- 4 Funding of constructing the building would suggest the need to build more houses and so it continues...
- 5 All my original objections stand, and have only been strengthened by this red herring.
