<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I object to this proposal on the following grounds&lt;br/&gt;1. It has made false claims in literature sent to village residents . This in particular around the doctors surgery and the parish council being supportive&lt;br/&gt;2 the plan for the development does not look realistic for the area it plans to build on so would be a lot less green space than advised&lt;br/&gt;3. 60 houses would add more pressure on the services in the village . It is already difficult now to get appointments at the doctors and the school is struggling having gone from outstanding to needs improvement&lt;br/&gt;4 Lots of wildlife live in the field and this would destroy their habitat&lt;br/&gt;5. 60 houses would change the dynamic of the village and move it away from the community it is now which holds the richness of village life&lt;br/&gt;6. The roads in cropredy do not support the increase in traffic as there is very limited public travel available&lt;br/&gt;I am not against a smaller number of houses such as 15 as long as the above is taken into consideration"/>
