Comments

The application for additional housing is strongly opposed for the following reasons:

We do not believe the proposal adequately addressed the need for additional infrastructure in terms of highways, education, sustainable drainage or flood defence.

Furthermore the development is not in keeping with the rural identity of Cropredy. Cropredy is an attractive Oxfordshire village and this significant development would be detrimental to that identity. The village demonstrably attracts many tens of thousands of tourists throughout the year due to its charming character, which brings valuable revenue to the village and wider Banbury area. Placing this at risk is not in the interest of the local area.

We do not consider the ecology of the local area would be adequately protected by the proposed loss of habitat, in particular damage caused to an area rich in rare amphibians and other important species.

Finally we note the argument for a larger GP surgery. There appears to be no tangible data to support the proposal, I would ask that the Planners consider this closely. The proposed does not seam to be viable with the village even including the additional housing. A robust business case should be available for scrutiny prior to this being considered as part of the application.
