Hi David,

We have the following comments regarding the scope of the proposed junction traffic surveys:

- Trip distribution to/from the site is based on the spread of potential visitors in a 125-mile radius. This does not take into account the large proportion of trips made by staff, which are likely to be primarily local to the Bicester area. Therefore, it is probable that a higher proportion will turn right out of the site along the A4095. With this in mind, we consider that the Vendee Drive / B4030 / Howes Lane roundabout should be surveyed. It can then be included in the TA if further study of the staff trips show that it will be necessary.
- The northbound route passes through the signalised junction at Middleton Stoney. As this intersection already experiences capacity issues we consider that it should be included in the assessment.
- The forecast Saturday peak trip generation is roughly double the weekday peaks. Traffic on the A41 is roughly similar between mid-week and Saturday,

although the Saturday peak occurs at 12:00 – 13:00. It is not known if the Bicester Office Park TA covers Saturdays so, if not, a traffic survey of the A41 / Vendee Drive junction is required on a Saturday. The other Vendee drive junctions (with the A4095 and the B4030/Howes Lane) should also be surveyed on a Saturday.

Sorry for the late response, and I hope this makes sense. If you need to discuss further before our meeting, please contact Tim as I will be out the office Thursday and Friday on election duty.
