ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(a) THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEAR LOWER FULBROOK, WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC IN LAYBY) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the A46 Trunk Road, near Lower Fulbrook, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable resurfacing works to be carried out to a layby.

The effect of the Order will be to close the layby situated adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the A46 approximately 450 metres northeast of the roundabout junction of the A46 with the A439, near Lower Fulbrook.
