(BICESTER) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (AMENDMENT NO.19) ORDER 2021

NOTICE is given that on 16th August Oxfordshire County Council made the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order, which comes into force on 23 August is to **Prohibit Right Turn** onto Bicester Road (Launton) from the new access road located approximately 46 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A4421, ensuring that exiting vehicles turn left only towards the nearby roundabout. This work forms part of the East West Rail (Western Section) Phase 2 development works. This further amends the Oxfordshire County Council (Bicester) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1992. ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1) Notice of Temporary Traffic Order

Tackley- unnamed road
Prohibition of Through Traffic
Date of Order: 16 August 2021
Coming into force: 24 August 2021

This Order is being introduced because of utility ducting works which are anticipated to be completed on 30 August 2021.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding in that part of the unnamed single carriageway north-eastwards between Station Road and Whitehill Satellite Station

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road. The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via Road through Lower Whitehill – Gibraltar Hill and vice versa.
