Comments	<input type="text" value="Firstly, the description of the plot is incorrect. Fringford Study Centre has been a dwelling known as The Old School since 2003. This is far from the first time that an application has been made for this plot of land. All previous applications and appeals, even as far as The Secretary of State, have failed. Since the very first application, the only change that there has been in Rectory Lane is that traffic has increased greatly. Every house now seems to have 2/3 cars and with more on-line shopping there is an endless stream of speeding white vans. Another house would only increase the vehicle movement on this single track road making it even more dangerous for pedestrians. The approval of the application for 4 houses now known as Farriers Close had a condition that the plot now under consideration be left undeveloped to be used as a community amenity. Surely that condition still applies."/>
