Comments	<input type="text" value="Ambrosden, we have been told by the Council, is a sustainable village. But with 3 large developments in the last few years, we have reached capacity. There are now another 3 developers applying for planning permission thus one included and in the last 2 weeks another 2 areas of fields have been assessed with a view to develop. The shops regularly run out of stock, not from lack of trying to maintain items, the infrastructure is not being upgraded to meet the new demands from the new estates, adding more will only increase the problems already being experienced by the residents. The school is at maximum capacity with young children having to travel further afield. The secondary schools are full in Bicester. There are no new ones being built at this time, so where do these children go. We have a pub, hardly open and it's like entering some one's front room. There isn't a warm reception. It's nigh on impossible to get a doctors or dentist appointment. These are soft infrastructure, but important, nonetheless. These issues continue to be disregarded by the Planners. It might be an idea to visit Ambrosden and see the true situation instead of rubber stamping every application. Come and talk to us, hear our views instead of ignoring all our objections."/>
