<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I wish to formally object to the proposed development on the grounds that there has already been a huge amount of housing development in Ambrosden. Ambrosden is a village, at least it is supposed to be, but this development will push the village even closer to becoming just an extension of Bicester.&lt;br/&gt;There is already a huge traffic problem through the village.&lt;br/&gt;There is not the infrastructure to support yet more housing- the school is already at capacity, therefore any new families will have to drive from and to schools out of the village. I also object on the grounds of environmental damage- light pollution , increased noise, yet more removal of green space, destruction of natural habitats, including those of protected species such as the crested newt.&lt;br/&gt;I fear damage to the pathway and ancient hedgeway that borders the site and West Hawthorn Road. This is currently a quiet lane, maintained by money from maintenance fees of residents of the private roads on West Hawthorn. It gives residents access to quiet, green spaces which will be destroyed by the planned new development."/>
