Comments	<p>Here are my valid points of objection:</p> <p>Impact of increased traffic through the village and when exiting onto the A41 as this is route notorious for accidents and is even more dangerous now as it is a HS2</p> <p>Impact on already strained utilities including water availability and pressure, power and internet (there was no consideration made for this in the Ploughley Road application)</p> <p>Lack of infrastructure and amenities (no restaurants, limited sports facilities, shop which does not meet needs of the village.</p> <p>Issues around ownership of the bridleway which has been earmarked as an access point.</p> <p>Schooling - both primary and secondary. Children are already being turned away from Whitelands, our catchment school. Where will any new children go? How will they get there?</p> <p>Availability of sixth form education as children in the current Year 7, 8 and year groups will not have access to a sixth form at Whitelands Academy</p> <p>Insufficient public transport links</p> <p>Lack of facilities for older children - we do NOT need another play park!</p> <p>Noise impact and 30/40% increase on the environment with traffic flow.</p> <p>Environmental impact - crested newts, deer, badgers, foxes all Wildlife in general.</p> <p>Crime in village - this is likely to rise.</p> <p>Ploughley road increased housing on land that floods that will impact on the environment.</p>
