YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

This Appeal would appear to identify two distinct issues associated with Planning Application 23/00662/F:

- 1. Validation process and procedure
- 2. Specific detail of the planning application

Validation process and procedure:

While some elements of 23/00662/F were displayed on the Cherwell District Council (CDC) Planning website in late March/early April 2023, all reference was removed from the site prior to the Parish Council Meeting held on 5th April. As a direct consequence, all opportunity for public comment and discussion was no longer possible.

Subsequently, CDC have identified the application as "Application did not pass validation" (CDC Planning Committee Appeal Progress Report, 5th October 2023). Given that this Appeal is brought citing Non-Determination, the ability to make any determination on an application which would appear not to exist presents a confusing and difficult challenge, requiring detailed and specific clarification prior to, and separate from, any future planning application.

Specific detail of the planning application:

As previously stated, the CDC Planning website posted some elements of the planning application. It is noted that further documentation provided by the Appellant has now been posted in association with this Appeal, although without any form of the original Design and Access Statement. However, the Revised Appeal Statement indicates various Exhibits (identified in 4.0, 5.4 and 6.0). These appear to refer to another document which has not been made available. The detail of these Exhibits is not provided which is both confusing and potentially misleading.

Recognising the extensive planning history associated with this sensitive conservation area location, the incomplete nature of the evidence provided, together with the lack of transparency associated with the initial validation process, it would seem appropriate for the original planning application to be formally resubmitted, with all relevant documentation.
