Hi Bob

As indicated under the previous application I am concerned about the viability of western and southern boundary structural vegetation in this scheme. The over shadowing of gardens from hedges and trees will encourage residents of plots 5,6,7 and 8 to reduce the height of this vegetation/removal of trees, resulting in increased visual impact from the PRow to the west.

The recorded photographic views should comply with LI guidance. The medium and distant views photos should be digitally stitched together panoramas, taken with a 50 mm lens, and printed as A3 allow the observer to consider them at a distance of 30 cm from eye to the photograph to gain an idea of the actual scale of the site within the landscape.
