I wish to register my objection to the proposal by Gladman to build a further 95 new houses in Bloxham.

As you know, Bloxham has experienced 50% growth in the last 10-15 years, with 220 new houses already and 3 substantial developments in the last 5 years. The primary school is full and cannot expand. The shopping area is congested all the time. Traffic on the A361 is intolerably heavy, with many HGVs. Walking on some stretches of pavement is frightening and dangerous, with HGV and coach mirrors often overlapping the pavement. Pedestrians trying to cross the A361 and drivers trying to turn out on to the road are very frequently faced with nose to tail convoys of traffic in both directions. Air quality on the High Street is low. The estimated increase of 150 cars in the village is bound to increase these problems. The proposed new houses are contrary to our Neighbourhood Plan, and would be outside our building line. They would enclose the Recreation Ground.

The village infrastructure is already being stretched to breaking point and the Gladman proposal would cause a further deterioration in so many ways that it must not be approved.
