3. Bloxham is already very congested and this will just to the problem.
4. The people of Bloxham approved a Neighbourhood Plan in November 2016 to try to manage the development of the village. This development would contravene the agreed plan.
5. As an elderly resident who enjoys walking in the Slade, I would be very sad to see it threatened by this development.
