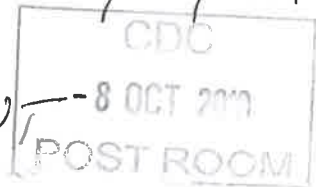

As a Bloxham resident for the last 28 years I would like to express my objections to the proposed Gladman development.

* BL 9 Impact of increased traffic. This will be dangerous especially given the location of the access onto the A361 (already highlighted as an accident hotspot) The roundabout (South Newington) is already at full capacity and recent surveys have noted it cannot be improved. The centre of the village by the shops is especially busy and parking is very limited. The schools are full and cannot cope with anymore development (Bloxham is a hub for satellite villages - and I understand that Milcombe has had planning past for 40 more homes - this will further impact on Bloxham.)

* BL 12

The Recreation Ground at present is heavily used; it is a wonderful resource to the community, rural outlook lovely for sports, childrens play area, dog walking etc. People and animals enjoying fresh air and rural views. This will all be lost if it is enclosed by housing.

The flood risk is well known in this part of the village and it is appalling in my opinion if housing development will cause increased pressure on drainage etc, and also impact on the Slade Nature Reserve which is wonderful area for wildlife - a peaceful, tranquil site for all to enjoy.

Our village has grown considerably over recent years but now it is at saturation point. Please NO MORE!
