I am writing to object to the proposed developed of additional housing in Bloxham (Planning application 19/01705/OUT)

Many residents of the village spent a great deal of time & effort in developing a Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) for the Village & its future. This NDP has been adopted.

The proposed development was not envisaged in the Plan, the proposed development falls outside the Village boundary on green open space. The Cherwell Local Plan specifies a total of 750 new homes to be developed in category A Villages such as Bloxham, this object has already been achieved or plans approved for such.

The NDP was specific in retaining the local character, historical & local assets. The open space where the proposed development is intended flies in the face of preserving the Village's open spaces & biodiversity.

In addition, the proposed 95 houses will further exacerbate the Village infrastructure: Surgery, local schools, all of which are full.

The existing traffic volumes on the Village & on the A361 are unacceptable.

Finally what is the point of in spending time effort & money in developing a Neighbourhood Plan if it is to be ignored at the earliest opportunity?

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
