I would like to add my voice to those expressing concern about the Gladman Proposal, to build yet more houses in Bloxham.

In my view, and I suspect in the view of the majority of people living in the area, Bloxham is already suffering from over-development: there have been three major building developments in the past five years and 50% growth in the last 10-15 years. It certainly feels as though this village has taken a bigger hit than any other in the immediate area. Our existing facilities, especially the primary school are being stretched to the limit. Parking in the village is very problematic and creates regular problems on the A361 through the village.

The lack of a neighbourhood plan was the previous excuse for the village being excessively targeted for building development. I believe this is no longer a valid reason, so why does Bloxham continue to be targeted unfairly by predatory developers?
