I cannot believe that yet another housing developer is contemplating building even more houses in the village of Bloxham. When my wife I came her just under four years ago there had recently been a housing development in Milton Road and another smaller development was being built in Barford road which I considered at the time was reasonable for a village the size of Bloxham. Although it was said soon after we came that the schools were at their full capacity and we found that the High Street was getting very busy. Our two immediate neighbours who each have two children had to continue to take them all to primary schools in Banbury instead of moving them to the village primary school.

Since then another development has been built opposite the primary school any yet another on quite large is still being built in Milton road not to mention another two built less than a mile further down the Milton road at Adderbury. To top it all there are two enormous developments being built less than two miles away on the A361 (that runs through Bloxham High Street) at the edge of Banbury one of which is actually called "Bloxham Vale".

Getting children into the Bloxham schools must now be virtually impossible, the doctors surgery seem to be getting harder to access and the traffic in and around the village is absolutely terrible, I was in a traffic que today that ran from the Bloxham school to the small roundabout at Barford road.

All these developments along with the already heavy existing traffic in and around the village have caused congestion on all of the roads accessing and passing through the village, so much so that it is now impossible for me to walk down the roads to the village because of the extremely high level of pollution from the vehicles.

There must be more suitable sites for you to build your houses, there must be more suitable places that are not overwhelmed by new building projects. Building more houses in Bloxham would be final straw and you would completely wreck this once pleasant village not only for the people who live here but also for the people who you would sell these houses to. The existing services and facilities cannot deal with even more people and another new development would be detrimental to the village and would certainly not enhance it. Please do not build even more houses in Bloxham which are already ruining the character of the village and spoiling its ability to function as pleasant rural location to live.
