OBJECTION TO FURTHER HOUSING PLANNING IN BLOXHAM

You will have received a plethora of objections raising a myriad of issues to the latest planning of 95 houses in Bloxham.

I would support many of them but there are two I wish to reinforce.

Firstly, the village has in no way the infrastructure to support the recent developments let alone this future proposal. 106 money from developers does nothing to address the chronic overcrowding of roads, amenities, schools and medical practices. Indeed the 106 scheme is patronising. Communities such as this need extra schools, bypasses and shops if developments are not to impact negatively on people, not a lick of paint for a play area.

Secondly, the pollution levels are already significantly worrying according to CDC's own measurements.
