Stonewalls, The Leys, Adderbury, Banbury, OX17 3ES

I object to this development for the following reasons:- Access to the site is dangerous via the Leys which is a small lane with no footpath and no turning or passing points. Vehicles meeting have no option other than to reverse into blind areas due to the curvature of the lane and its junctions at Tanners lane and the waterworks roadway. Heavy vehicles already have great difficulty in negotiating into and within the Leys and the increased traffic during construction and subsequently would greatly increase the safety to pedestrians and vehicles alike. Pedestrians currently have to climb a bank in the absence of a footpath to allow vehicles to pass and this is a well used lane by walkers. The need for the removal of a great many trees for this development is so contrary to current green policies demanding the need for tree planting that it defies all logic as does the description of the land as scrub area rather than a neglected back garden of the applicant. should this become acceptable criteria it may become more widely practised. The land proposed for development is prone to flooding and can only worsen this condition The proximity to the conservation area makes a mockery of the principle of conservation.
