I strongly object to the above application for a plethora of reasons: The proposed buildings are inside a conservation area which we use on a daily basis for runs and dog walking. This area is not designed for vehicle access, when it is accessed for the purposes of the water company this proves problematic to navigate. Erecting these properties is not imperative and does not support those wishing to live within the village in standard housing. It may state that there are five bedrooms, however, the full excess of the properties can be viewed and is not something that will enrich the landscape of our village. Building work will cause irreparable damage to the woodland and narrow lanes. This will also be compounded as the single-track lane into the proposed site has no public footpaths it will impact on the safety of local children and pedestrians using the lane to access the playing fields and local area footpaths. The impact upon wildlife and vegetation is a prime concern, felling trees that provide a natural heritage and the destruction of habitats of local wildlife and their environment. The area has flooded on a number of occasions and there has been contamination of the ground by raw sewage caused by a failure at the pumping station situated in the area.
