| Comments | <p>Whilst I have no objection to the barns being converted on the site, I do object to the creation of a new driveway and access on the main road. This is already a lethal part of the road. There are parked vehicles (especially at peak school drop off/collection times) making it dangerous access point for other vehicles and pedestrians. The school and public buses can already barely turn around the corner at the crossroads without damaging parked vehicles or running over the pavement. To then create a driveway/access road here would be unbelievably dangerous, thoughtless to other residents and potentially lethal for pedestrians, crucially children walking to and from school. It would be foolish to only look at this planning at a quiet time of day, for example a Sunday. It needs to be examined at 8.40am and 2.50pm when school traffic, pedestrians, parked cars and buses are using the road. There is already an access road around the corner up the hill - why can this not be used? It makes no sense to create this additionally access and sadly, if this goes ahead, it will only be a matter of time before there is a fatality. I strongly object to this planning proposal.
