Comments	<p>It will be good to see this part of the village brought back to life after many years, and I support the plan to have two new homes on this site. But I oppose this application in its current form on the grounds of both safety and congestion. Vehicles come round the blind corner from Pound Lane into Main Street very quickly. Any movements in the area of the proposed new opening are dangerous as the visibility is poor and the road narrow. Children on foot or on scooters will be at risk with cars crossing the footpath. Any more cars parking on Main Street are likely to bring the village to a standstill. There are already enough problems at certain times of the day, especially for the coaches carrying schoolchildren. Access to this site should only be via Pound Lane. In addition, I think this application should be refused unless and until proper provision is made for off-street parking for Mawles Cottage (formerly Mawles Farmhouse) which I understand is in the same ownership. This provision should also be from Pound Lane. We are told that there has not been a personal injury traffic accident in Sibford for over twenty years. Let us keep it that way!</p>
