I have serious concerns regarding the proposed new access to Main St. not only does this seriously affect the aesthetic of this part of the village but it puts users of the narrow public foot path at risk I also doubt that there is enough visibility to pull onto the road from the proposed entrance due to parked cars something that is due to increase as a result of this whole site being split up and the original 4 bedroom farm house being sold off with no parking. Parking should be provided for the original farm house and any development via the existing wide access on pound lane. I would also like to object on the grounds that every proposed building on this site is to be large. Villages tend not to suffer from a lack of large houses as the natural tendency is to extend over time.
