Having multiple venues on the site will undoubtedly increase car traffic, thus increasing the amount of pollution in the area. The weekends will undoubtedly be when they host most of the events, a time whereby I am most at home and have a chance to relax. The noise pollution at times is bad enough already at weekends when events are hosted, but to increase that will have a major negative effect on our neighbouring estate. I make a 25-mile commute by car to work every day to Milton Keynes. I am also concerned that construction works will also have an effect on the neighbouring area with road closures, major delays, etc. Finally, it can already be dangerous at times trying to get out of Skimmingdish Lane, Caversfield. Increasing the amount of traffic using the stretch of road will make this worse, especially when individuals speed down the A4421 (apologies for stereotyping, but the reality is that the culprits are often those with sports cars that attend BH event days already)."/>
