Comments	<input type="text" value="I strongly object to this planning application on the grounds that it will make what is already a worsening situation unbearable as follows: 1. The local roads are struggling to sustain the current volume of traffic, during busy periods the waiting times on the ring road in either direction are in excess of 10 minutes, a year ago there was no waiting time. 2. A race track will introduce a great deal of NOISE, currently there is very little except on the current Bicester Heritage Scramble days when we get aircraft, cars and tannoys. 4 days of this a year is fine, 24+ a year is not. 3. Air pollution will also be an issue with additional traffic, race cars, aircraft and no doubt additional generators for the recreational facilities. 4. Ill health will also increase with the air pollution and greatly affect Bicester already struggling medical services. 5. That covers when the proposed development is running, it has to be built first and all the above would apply again during the construction phase with the additional a. Air pollution from concrete dust and other building materials b. Wet and muddy roads which rarely get cleaned and exacerbate the road damage already present. Current proposal for Bicester are already going to worsen the situation with the garden town, eco-village, several hotels and numerous warehouses and potentially a water park. What was a lovely little market town is becoming an eyesore and unpleasant place to live, don't do this and take away our heritage."/>
