<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="This expansion would very negatively affect the lives of residents of Caversfield, Bure Park, Southwold, Cherwood House care home, Launton Village and the wider Bicester community. Traffic along the Buckingham Road is already a daily issue for local residents, at peak commuting times it is often completely gridlocked and extremely difficult for drivers to pull out onto the Buckingham Road. The events held by Bicester Heritage to date have only amplified this and further expansion would cause even more chaos. Bicester Heritage are also trying to force the Gliding Club out of their home prior to this expansion which would involve building a racing circuit on part of their airfield. This would increase air pollution and noise pollution for the many homes nearby Bicester Heritage. The gliding club is a historic part of life in Bicester, furthermore it is a silent and environmentally friendly hobby for many locals passionate about aviation. The same cannot be said for the proposed development. The seemingly endless streams of loud, powerful sports cars that can be seen arriving at Bicester Heritage for their events contribute to air and noise pollution which disturbs the lives of residents. This would drastically increase if their expansion goes ahead and their events become more regular. The developers very clearly have their own profits and business ambitions at heart and seem to completely disregard the effects that their actions would have on the people who live nearby and the environment.
