| Comments | <p>Having read the plethora of information attached to this application, I must object on four points: 1, Why does this building need to be so large, we are told it's a village amenity, we are only a small village in size and population, this building would be more suited at a town environment 2. The traffic flow details relate to a period in 2016, I can assure as a resident of Henge Close that the traffic volumes and associated speeds are far in excess of the quoted figures 3. As a resident of Henge Close we were told that there would be no floodlights, if that is the case, how do the parish council justify the opening hours of the facilities, we live in a small village, floodlights represent a substantial level of light pollution, which given that OCC Highways feel we do not require any additional street lighting in the village is a little rich. 4. We are informed similar (potentially identical) facilities are planned for the land on the approach to Twyford from Banbury, if this is the case, do we really need the Milton Road development.
